OVERVIEW

Main Street Skowhegan is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to the ongoing revitalization of Skowhegan, Maine. Founded in 2005 by a committed group of local citizens, Main Street Skowhegan works to strengthen the community through economic development, placemaking, outdoor recreation, entrepreneurship, and events.

Our work is powered by a dedicated staff, AmeriCorps members, a committed Board of Directors, and more than 200 volunteers who help bring major initiatives and community events to life.

Our mission is to celebrate Skowhegan's rich heritage while building a strong future as a thriving economic, cultural, and recreational community where residents and visitors alike can enjoy a high quality of life.

Current Projects and Initiatives

- **Skowhegan Outdoors** — free outdoor recreation programs and gear lending based at 65 Water Street
- **Skowhegan Center for Entrepreneurship** — coworking, meeting space, trainings, business support, and events at 181 Water Street

- **Business Lab and Pitch Competitions** for entrepreneurs, including youth entrepreneurs

- **Riverfront development** fundraising and project management, with more than \$2 million raised
- **Trail planning, development, and enhancement** throughout Skowhegan

- **Skowhegan marketing efforts**, including visitor guides, VisitSkowhegan.com, and @VisitSkowhegan social media channels
- **Events and festivals** that bring people to Skowhegan and support local businesses
- **The Langlais Art Trail**, promoting Skowhegan's 20+ Bernard Langlais sculptures as part of a broader Maine arts experience
- **Community beautification efforts**, including street pole banners, birdhouses, riverfront green spaces, holiday lights, and the Triangle Garden
